### Position Overview

Performs examinations on patients as prescribed by the physician to provide quality-imaging studies, regarding patient condition for diagnostic purposes. Reviews studies for clarity and accuracy, and may take additional films to assist the Radiologist.

### General Responsibilities

- Exhibits behaviours that are consistent with the Mission, Philosophy, and Values of Pershing General Hospital and Nursing Home as well as the culture and objectives of Pershing General Hospital and Nursing Home. All employees are expected to work as needed in providing health and wellness services in the communities within Pershing General Hospital and Nursing Home.
- Demonstrates effective skills with the communication, organization and management of assigned work.
- Performs diagnostic exams independently to physician's orders in using correct modalities to assure accurate and optimal diagnostic results.
- Retrieves and returns patient to appropriate area and prepares room for next study in timely fashion with a friendly customer service attitude.
- Records appropriate patient information and maintain all records according to established guidelines. Performs regular quality control checks and required paperwork as necessary to comply with regulatory standards.
- Maintains a safe environment for patient and staff, to include the ALARA Concept as prescribed by PGH, NAC and applicable standards of care.
- Demonstrates a basic understanding of Quality Improvement/Quality Assurance in the organization.
- Demonstrates knowledge of radiation safety procedures, exposure factors, and restraint methods to ensure quality of patient care.
- Other responsibilities and duties as assigned on occasion, based upon PGH need or requirements.
- Wears identification while on duty. Adheres to dress code, appearance is neat and clean. Completes annual education requirements. Maintains regulatory requirements, including all state and federal regulations. Maintains and ensures patient confidentiality at all times. Reports to work on time and as scheduled. Attends annual review and performs departmental inservices. Works at maintaining a good rapport and a cooperative working relationship with physicians, departments and staff. Represents the organization in a positive and professional manner. Attends committee, QI and management meetings, as appropriate. Ensures compliance with policies and procedures regarding department operations, fire, safety, and infection control. Complies with all organizational policies regarding ethical business practices.

### Qualifications

Completion of an accredited program in Radiologic Technology or Ultrasound. Six Months experience in X-ray and CT or US. 24 hours of continuing education every 2 years.

Manual dexterity and physical agility to operate all equipment and perform all procedures.

To be able to perform examinations in X-ray and Computerized Tomography or Ultrasound.

Utilizes safe body mechanics to ensure patient and caregiver safety.
